Registration eligibility for *The High Tide*

Conference registration is open to those:

- Employed directly by a law firm in a MBD function. Those who work for law firms in a self-employed or agency capacity (e.g. fractional CMO, consultant) do not meet the criterion; and
- Not actively practising law (understanding some lawyers make the career change to MBD, for clarity this means the person does not engage in any billable client work).
- Registration is limited to two participants per firm initially to allow for a breadth of firm types and experiences. Registrants from a single firm will be processed on a first come, first served basis, and any registrants in excess of two will be waitlisted and contacted if space allows.

Eligibility will be verified. If, after payment, an individual is found not to be in compliance with the above criteria, their registration will be cancelled and no refund will be paid.

Payment must be received within 5 business days of the registration being confirmed. If payment is not received in this timeframe the place will be forfeited and the individual will only be able to re-register if space is still available.

Registration costs for The High Tide

- The High Tide is a business development and marketing conference put on by MBD professionals for MBD professionals on a not-for-profit basis. To cover the costs of the venue, breakfast, lunch, cocktails, staffing and technology, participants are required to contribute 1800 DKK (early-bird 1300 DKK), before July 31, 2026). A transaction receipt will be provided, but the conference neither charges tax, nor provides tax receipts.
